- Ad 8) Presentation and orientation of the new study curriculum for the Immunology and Inflammation study programme Head of studies, Anders Woetmann, presented the ideas for the new study curriculum for the MSc in Immunology and Inflammation, which will start from September 2024.

A new course 'Computational Immunology' will be implemented in the first semester. The study board was introduced to the course description.

The course will have an oral examination with assessment form passed/not passed. The students will have a one week assignment prior to the oral examination.

Furthermore, elements from the new course (bioinformatics) will be implemented in some of the other existing courses, so the students will use the knowledge continuously throughout the programme. The course in Laboratory Animal Science will be an elective course instead of compulsory.

The course 'Allergy, Autoimmunity and Inflammation' will be reduced from 15 ECTS to 7,5 ECTS.

The study board discussed the presentation and supported the ideas for the new study curriculum.

The changes will be finally approved in the study board in September and November 2023.

Ad 9) Miscellaneous

It was pointed out that communication regarding the Meet n' Greet should be clearer and reach out to all students across the three programmes. A lot of the students in the Immunology programme missed the information the last time it was carried out.

The study board discussed the procedure for dispensation for exam withdrawal. It was noted that the examiner should be informed if the student applies for dispensation, as the deadline is very late and because it can take up until 10 workdays before the dispensation will be answered. It was suggested to inform the students about this procedure on Absalon.
