Ad 4) Approval of continuation of summer course in 2026 (MSc in Human Biology): SHUA13040U International Summer course Forensic and Genetics and Massively Parallel Sequencing

The study board approves the continuation of the course. The Board requested clarification of the need for annual approval despite the course running smoothly each year.

[Annual approval is standard for summer courses. The Board's wish for general approval has been noted. The course will continue without yearly approval unless structural or content changes occur.]

- The administration agreed to send out additional information to the students outlining their options. The administration will also overrule the general procedures for late registration for elective courses in block 1 and 2 at SUND.
