

Guidelines for supporting the international study environment

Each year, HEALTH admits a large number of international students, either for exchange studies or an English-language Master's programme or Professional Master's programme. To ensure integration and to facilitate the contact between Danish and international students, HEALTH has implemented a number of initiatives, including welcome and information meetings for exchange students and an extensive introductory programme for international and Danish students on English-language master's programme and professional master's programmes. Focus is on the international study environment, Internationalisation at Home and the development of intercultural competences.

The faculty offers a student-run mentor programme for international students on exchange or English-language master's programmes. The mentor programme provides practical assistance on their arrival to Denmark and supports experience sharing and networking across nationalities through a range of social events throughout the year.

HEALTH students have many opportunities to study abroad at the bachelor and especially the master's level, which are described on the study information pages on KUnet. The faculty also informs students of the opportunities through fairs, study programme specific information meeting, joint student counselling – and not least through International Student Counselling, where students can receive help in choosing a host institution as well as information on application procedures and scholarship possibilities. International Student Counselling is also open to incoming students.

International bachelor's and master's students can even before they arrive find information on the English-language study start pages on KUnet, which in addition to practical information also introduce the students to the study environment and life in Denmark.

Besides a number of English-language master's and professional master's programme, the faculty offers an increasing number of courses in English. HEALTH focuses on the development of pedagogic methods for use in the international classroom and in clinical teaching.

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
